live in the Arctic Circle. The lemming is a small animal like a mouse. It has a brown coat in the summer and a white coat in the winter. The Arctic fox also changes its color to white in the winter. During the summer it has a blue or gray coat. The white dolphin is a big animal which looks like a whale. It's white color protects it from other predators because it is the same color as the blocks of ice. It eats fish. Reindeer live in the Arctic too, in Siberia and Alaska. And there are birds: snowy owls, and albatrosses. Snowy owls are brown in the summer and white in the winter. Polar bears and seals are Arctic sea mammals. Seals eat fish

and polar bears eat seals! They live in and around the sea. Penguins don't live in the Arctic. They only live in the southern hemisphere, for example in the Antarctic and Patagonia.
