Do	Make
We use the verb 'do' when someone performs an action, activity or task.	We use the verb 'make' for constructing, building or creating
(do a crossword, do the ironing)	(make a dress, make a cup of tea)
'Do' is often used when referring to work of any kind.	'Make' is often used when referring to preparing food of any kind.
(do your work, do homework)	(make a meal - breakfast / lunch / dinner)

Verbos "do" " make"

"Do" y "make" son dos verbos que se confunden frecuentemente en inglés. Ambos se pueden traducir como "hacer", pero hay algunas diferencias en su significado. En general, "do" considera más la acción, mientras que utilizando "make" nos referimos más al resultado de la acción


