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Language Focus Verbs Make & Do

Do	Make
<p>We use the verb 'do' when someone performs an action, activity or task.</p> <p>(do a crossword, do the ironing)</p>	<p>We use the verb 'make' for constructing, building or creating</p> <p>(make a dress, make a cup of tea)</p>
<p>'Do' is often used when referring to work of any kind.</p> <p>(do your work, do homework)</p>	<p>'Make' is often used when referring to preparing food of any kind.</p> <p>(make a meal - breakfast / lunch / dinner)</p>

Verbos “do” “make”

- “**Do**” y “**make**” son dos verbos que se confunden frecuentemente en inglés. Ambos se pueden traducir como “hacer”, pero hay algunas diferencias en su significado. En general, “**do**” considera más la acción, mientras que utilizando “**make**” nos referimos más al resultado de la acción
