The race begins when the master of ceremonies violently throws a piece of cheese down a hill. All the competitors then throw themselves down the hill after the cheese. The winner keeps the cheese. Children can't take part in the competition, but there are a few uphill races, one for boys under 12 and one for girls. They are slower, but entertaining as well!
